

TOWN OF FALMOUTH ELECTION NOTICE

Absentee Ballots for the June 10, 2008, Municipal/State Referendum/Primary Election are available at the Town Clerk's Office at the Falmouth Town Hall, beginning Friday, May 9, 2008.

Registered voters may vote in person or contact the Town Clerk's Office to receive a ballot by mail. Telephone requests must be made by the voter only. In order to improve on the efficiency of the election we would encourage absentee voters to return their ballots or absentee vote before June 6th.

Requests by e-mail cannot be accepted.

Beginning **Wednesday, May 21, 2008, a new registration must occur in person.** The applicant must register in person, and show satisfactory proof of identity and residency to the Registrar, in order for the names to be added to the Incoming Voter List for Election Day.

Unenrolled voters may enroll in a party at any time, including Election Day, as this is not considered a change of enrollment.

Any voter who wishes to change their party affiliation to vote on June 10, 2008 must do so by **Friday, May 23, 2008 by 4:30 PM** in order to vote in the new party at the June primary.

Thursday, 8 AM – 5:30 PM.

Voters must remain in a party for 3 months before the voter can file an application for either a withdrawal or a change in enrollment.
